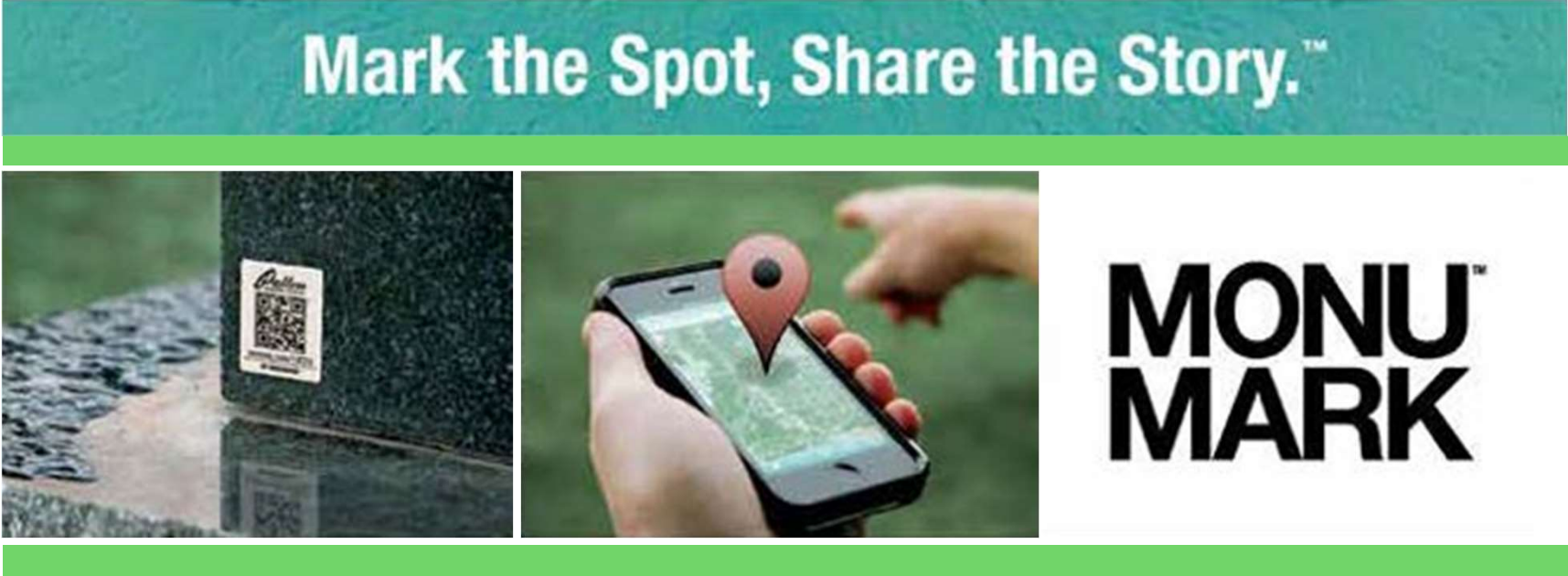

Requirements and Restrictions

(this applies to all headstones, regardless of where they are purchased)

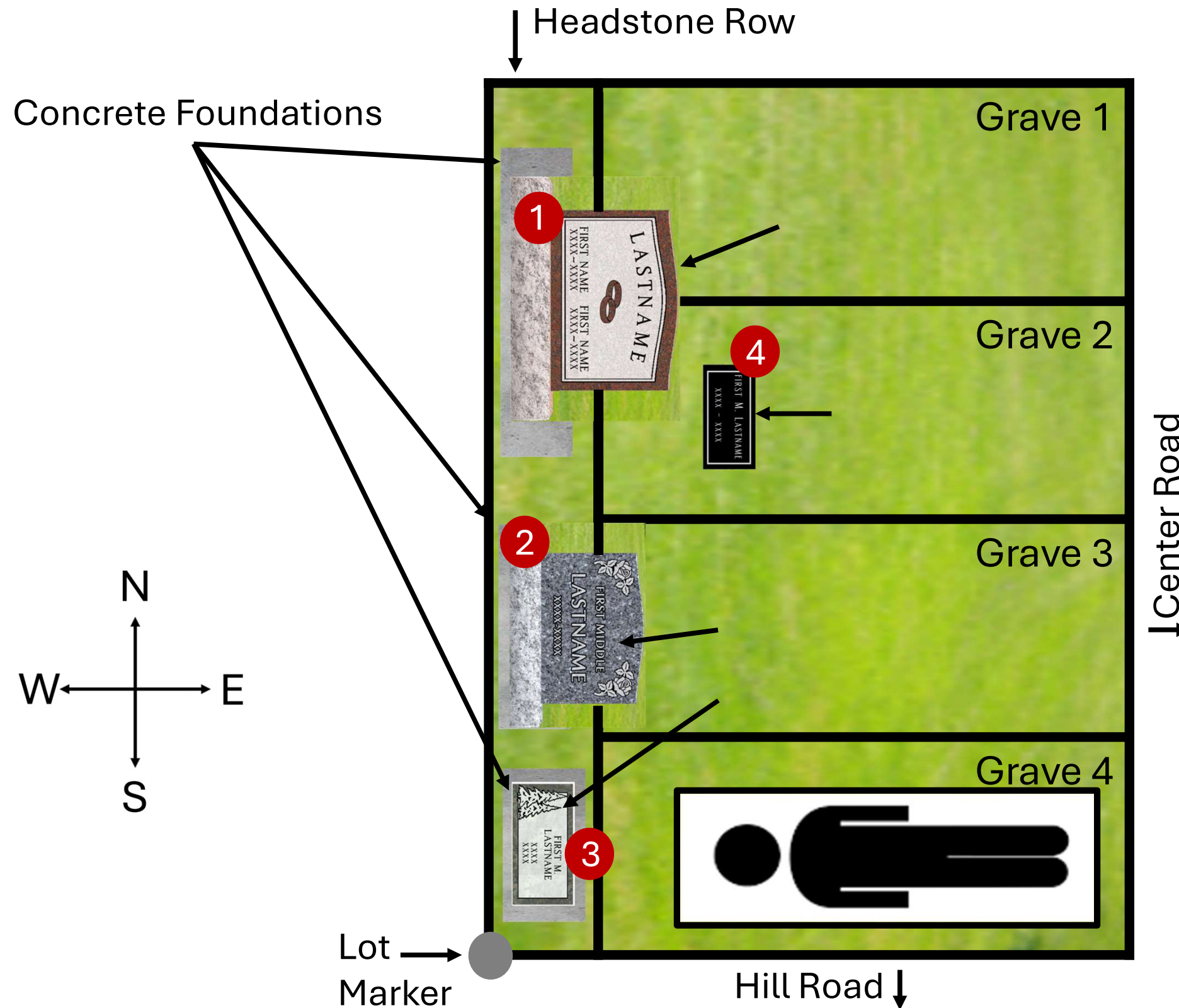
- Names and dates may appear on both sides of a marker; however, they **must** appear at minimum on the **WEST side** of the marker. Any monument set with names and dates appearing only on the east side will be turned to face the proper direction, regardless of whether the name placement aligns with the grave in which your loved one is buried. Please ensure your monument is produced with names and dates on the **WEST side** of the headstone. If you are unsure how your marker should be laid out, please feel free to contact me—I am happy to help ensure everything is done correctly.
- Markers that are not in the headstone row (or that are in the Singles Section) must be lawn level (flush with the grass). The mowers will need to travel over the top of them, so vases or other items that protrude from them are not allowed.
- Markers must be of authorized material only (granite, marble, bronze)
- Evergreen Cemetery does not accept deliveries of markers on your behalf. You must ensure that delivery/installation arrangements have been made. (If you are purchasing through Evergreen, Patten has already included all of this in the price of the granite)
- All markers require a foundation (or setting fee for lawn level markers) and must be ordered through the cemetery. Foundations are only to be installed by Evergreen Cemetery staff. Very large headstones (height over 48"), may need to have a deeper foundation installed to ensure it does not lean, which will increase the foundation fee. (Headstones large enough to require this are not common)
- The max headstone width (measurement east to west) is 24" for all sections.
- No limit on height.
- Markers spanning multiple graves may use the combined length of all graves. Length (measurement north to south) restrictions by section listed on the below table:

	1 grave	2 graves	3 graves	4 graves
Sections OD,ND,7, and 8	36"	72"	108"	144"
All other sections	40"	80"	120"	160"

Additional information

- Headstones are not required.
- Headstones may be placed pre-need.
- Markers can include names of more than one individual. This is often the case for a marker spanning multiple graves, but can also be the case for a marker on a single grave.
- Markers are not legal documents and can have names in the format that best suits you and your loved one, meaning it does not have to be the decedent's full legal name. Often times a nickname they were known by, a maiden name, a second married name, etc is listed. This is completely your preference.
- While anyone may place a headstone, final approval rests solely with the individual(s) who holds the burial rights to the grave. If you do not hold the burial rights, any headstone you place may be removed at the discretion of the burial rights holder. We strongly recommend obtaining written permission from all burial rights holders before purchasing a headstone. Grand Blanc Evergreen Cemetery is not responsible for any loss or expense incurred as a result of a headstone's removal.
- The restrictions and requirements listed are for Evergreen Cemetery. If you are ordering a headstone to be placed at a different cemetery, please be sure you are knowledgeable of their specific requirements and restrictions.

Evergreen Cemetery Lot Layout



This diagram represents how a lot is laid out

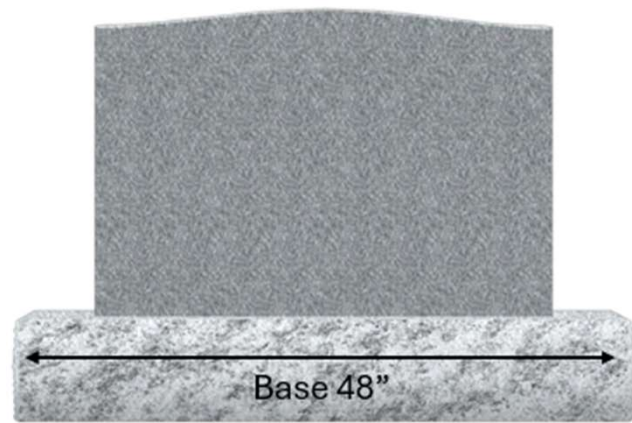
- Each lot has 4 graves, with grave 1 being to the north.
- Each lot has a lot marker in the southwest corner of grave 4.
- The body lies on the east side of the headstone, resting with the head to the west and feet to the east.

- 1 Represents a 36" tablet on a 48" base Upright style marker for two people centered, over two graves.
- 2 Represents a 30" tablet on a 40" base. Upright single headstone centered over one grave
- 3 Represents a 24"x12" Flush style headstone (on a foundation) centered over one grave
- 4 Represents a 20"x10" Flush style headstone, recessed and level with the ground

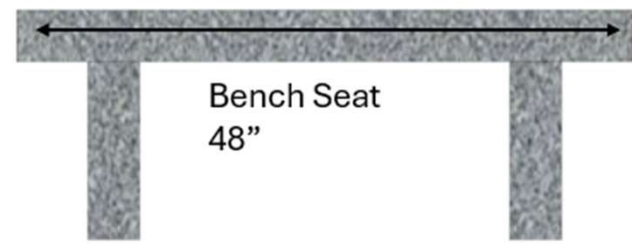
Foundation Information

The foundation/installation fee is \$10 per linear inch.
All Foundations will be installed by the cemetery staff.

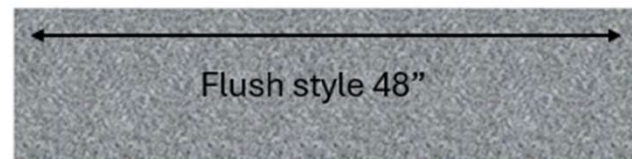
For each of the 48" headstones below the foundation fee would be \$480 (\$10 x 48")

A flush-style marker recessed into the grass on top of a grave (rather than placed in the headstone row) is charged at half of the standard \$10 per inch rate: 48" X \$5.00 = \$240.00

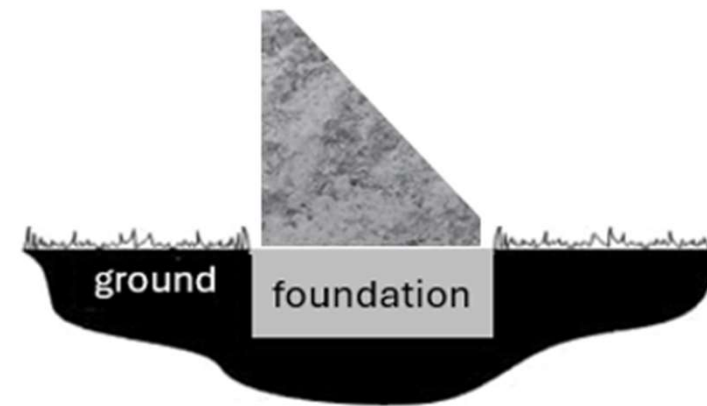
Side profile showing how each standard style headstone is situated on a concrete foundation.



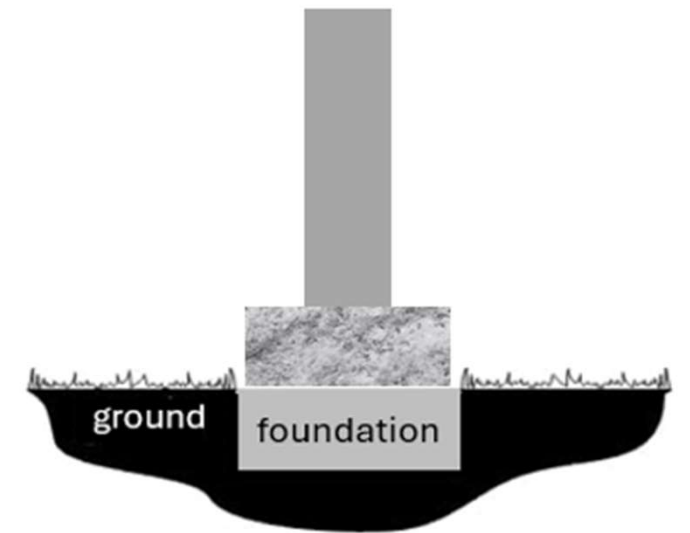
Flush in ground

Ordering Process Overview

Step 1 – Rough Draft. Once you have a general idea of what you would like, we can begin putting together a layout. The design system I use is intended for creating a rough draft to help visualize how your selections will look when placed together. While it is not a precise design system, it does an excellent job of providing a close representation.

Step 2 – Place Your Order. Along with the rough draft we will send a completed order agreement, and your initial payment to Patten. While Patten does not require payment in full to begin the order process, a partial payment of 50% would be due at this time. (The balance will not be due until the marker is delivered and installed, at which time an invoice will be sent from Patten Monument Co.) This payment can be made via cash, check, or credit card. (There is no fee to use a credit card)

Step 3 – Review and Approve Layout. Patten will create an official proof of the layout for you to review. I typically receive this 7-10 days after submitting the order. Once received, I will either mail a physical copy or email it to you, whichever you prefer. At this stage, you will want to carefully verify that spelling, dates, and placement as the stone will be produced exactly as approved. If you want to make changes to your layout, you are absolutely welcome to request a change anytime prior to your layout being approved. Your order will remain in HOLD status until you have approved the layout. Once approval is received production will begin if your headstone is a stock piece. If it is a custom order, the granite will be ordered at this time (the quarry cuts it specifically for your order), and production will begin once Patten receives your granite.

Step 4 – Foundation. Your concrete foundation will be installed while your headstone is in production. If your order is placed after October 16, or anytime while the ground is frozen the foundation will be placed once the ground thaws and temperatures are consistently above freezing. Patten will be notified when foundations are complete.

Step 5 – Delivery and Installation. Once your marker is complete and has been inspected for quality, Patten will deliver and install your marker. Delivery notification will be sent to me and I will notify you that everything is complete.

While you are always welcome to come into the office to place your order, the entire process can also be completed by mail or email if you prefer. My goal is to make this as easy as possible for you, so we can proceed in whatever way you find most convenient and comfortable.

There are four basic styles of headstones: **Flush, Bevel, Slant, and Upright**. There are also many alternative styles available, such as benches, boulders, and cremation memorials. If none of these feel quite right, custom designs are also an option.

Patten maintains on-hand stock of the four basic styles in their standard granite colors. Selecting a shape, size, and color that is currently stocked typically results in a shorter production time than choosing an option that must be ordered and shipped directly from the quarry. A variety of sizes are available to accommodate your needs.

Patten also offers special selections. Some of these are traditional styles and sizes, while many are alternative designs. These options are also kept in stock, though in more limited quantities, so occasionally there may be a short wait for the next shipment from the quarry.

On the next slide you will find a checklist that will help guide you as you make a selection.

Beyond that, you will find slides that included both the standard styles and the current special options for your review as well as color samples, finish options, lettering styles, fonts, and optional features.

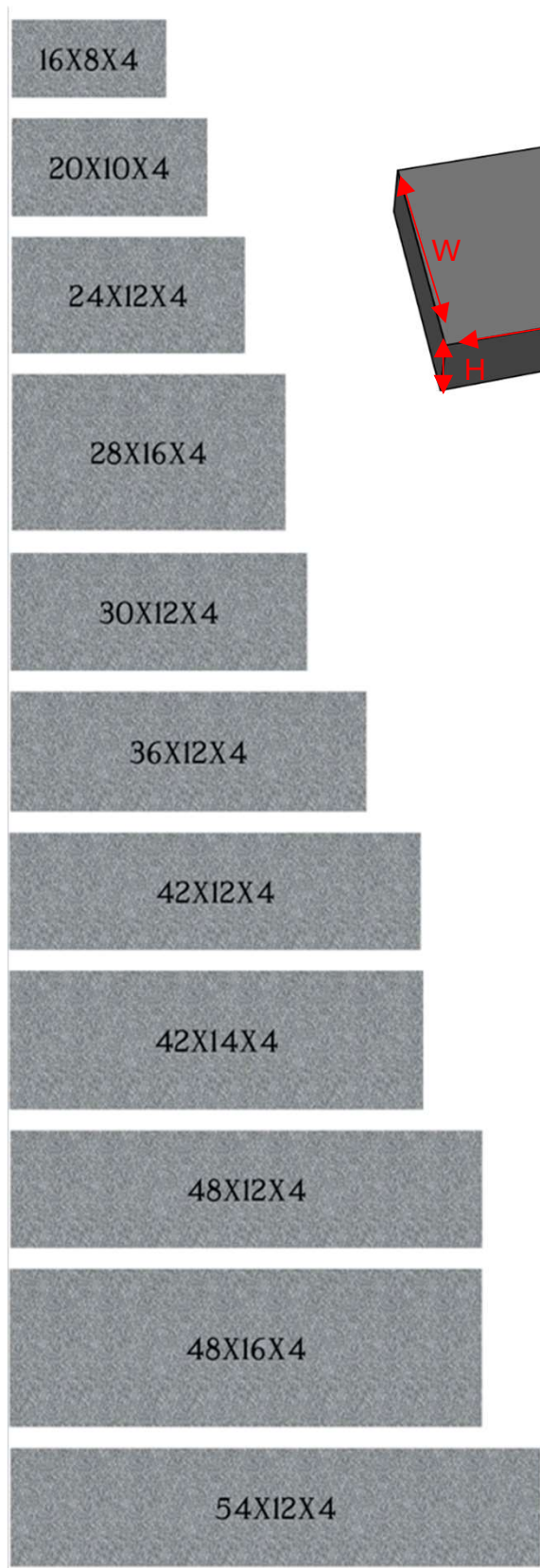
Please remember, this checklist was designed to help guide you through making your selection and is just a starting point. Nothing is final until Patten receives approval of a layout/proof from you. Until that happens, you can change anything about any of your selections at any time!

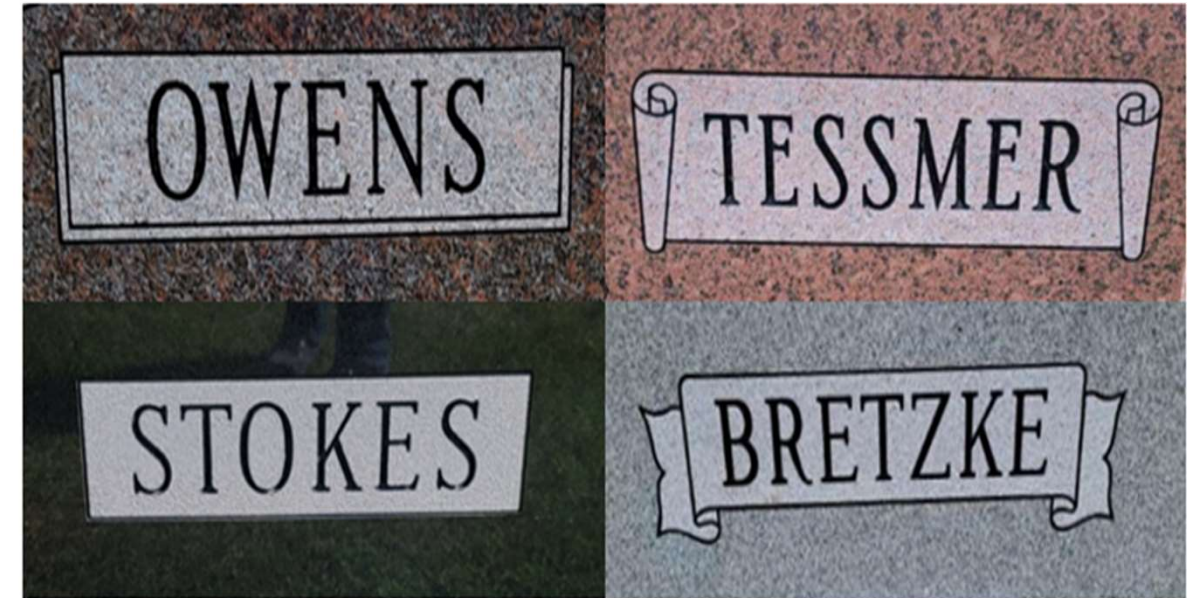
Finish Samples

- Should only be used on dark (black) granite



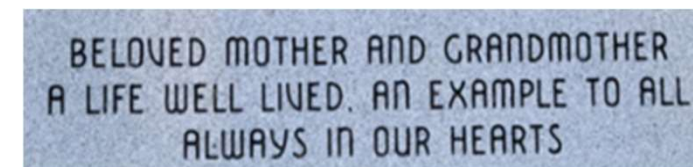

Photo Etching

A loved one's portrait can be permanently etched on a memorial. This can be done directly on the memorial when black granite is used. For other granite colors, a black granite insert that is counter sunk into the memorial is used.

Careful selection of the right photo is essential for the best result. The best reproductions are accomplished when using a professional 3x5, 5x7, or 8x10 portrait. Exceeding enlargement of 200% is not preferred as it can reduce the quality of the final product.

A note about granite durability...

Throughout history, many materials have been used to make monuments and memorials – from wooden sculptures and dirt mounds to gold and other precious materials to rocks and various stones.

Today, marble, granite and bronze are the most commonly used materials. While marble and granite are natural materials, mined from quarries all over the world; bronze is a man-made metal, formed from copper and zinc.

Patten Monument typically opts to use granite for the following reasons:

- Expansive range of colors, textures, and patterns.
- Engraving techniques and technology allow for virtually unlimited design options.
- Ability to vary finishes allows for unique design styles.
- Enhanced durability.

The National Park Service has extensively researched erosion rates of national granite memorials such as Mt. Rushmore. Their findings state that granite wears at the rate of 1 inch every 10,000 years. To put that into perspective, here's an example. Say a granite marker was made at the time of Christ's death (0 B.C.). Fast forward to today, and that very same marker will have eroded less than $\frac{1}{4}$ of an inch. Because there is so little difference in erosion rates between all memorial grade granites, Patten guarantees all of their granite equally.

Patten does not encourage the use of marble, due to the fact that it is a metamorphic stone and will wear much quicker than granite. If you look in your local cemetery at marble memorials over 100 years old, you will understand.

Patten also discourages using bronze for memorials, except when required by the cemetery. Because of its softness, lawnmower damage can happen and most people do not like the green patina that comes with age.
